3. Scientific Component

3.1 Summary

3.1.a Executive Summary (in Portuguese)

Os estudos metalinguísticos da língua Portuguesa, manuscritos e impressos, actualmente preservados em arquivos portugueses, são uma importante fonte documental para a constituição da Historiografia Linguística Portuguesa e Missionária de origem portuguesa. Este projecto pretende, em primeiro lugar, recolher manuscritos latino-portugueses dos séculos XIV e XV, textos fundacionais de investigação linguística, gramatical e pedagógico da Idade Média em Portugal; pretende, também, recolher as primeiras edições de textos gramaticais sobre a língua portuguesa tidos como epistemologicamente representativos dos estudos sobre a língua portuguesa dos séculos XVIII e XIX; e, ainda, trabalhos portugueses, produzidos em contexto colonial e missionário, e dedicados à análise de línguas nativas. Após a recolha desses documentos, este projecto pretende digitalizá-los e produzir e organizar estudos científicos que contextualizem, descrevam, as ideias linguísticas, educacionais e culturais aí presentes, mostrando, sempre que tal se verifique, evidências baseadas em dados comparativos, de maneira a fornecer uma avaliação dos quadros ideológicos, isto é, das ideias, envolvidos na produção metalinguística da época; concluindo pelo seu enraizamento na tradição metalinguística portuguesa, ou pelo seu contributo para a introdução de inovações no estudo da língua portuguesa. Também se prevê a elaboração de uma bibliografia actualizada e o mais abrangente dos trabalhos científicos (fontes secundárias) que, já publicadas ou ainda por publicar, quer a nível nacional quer internacional, tenham como objecto de análise. Assim, este projecto tornará possível a constituição de um corpus de metatextos linguísticos para estudar a evolução do pensamento gramatical e linguístico em Portugal, mas também a evolução da(s) língua(s) desde a Idade Média até ao século XX. Por isso, pretende-se também publicar, em forma impressa e/ou electrónica, edições semi-diplomáticas dos primeiros trabalhos publicados no Português do século XV, para contribuir para o desenvolvimento de um dicionário do Português Medieval e Renascentista. Pretende-se estudar, de um ponto de vista linguístico e cultural, os cinco Livros de Registos dos forais de D. Manuel I, do século XV, os Forais da região de Trás-os-Montes e Alto Douro desde o reinado de Fernando Magno de Castela ao reinado de D. Manuel I, bem como estudos diplomáticos e estudos lexicais e estatísticos. Também se realizará o estudo sincrónico da língua portuguesa de diferentes épocas do Português contemporâneo. Neste contexto, serão estudadas línguas minoritárias faladas em Portugal, como o Mirandês, e como o Barrosão, e alguns aspectos sociolinguísticos, nomeadamente as diferenças no uso da língua portuguesa por indivíduos de sexo masculino e feminino.

3.1.b Executive Summary (in English)

Metalinguistic studies of the Portuguese language, manuscripts and printed, currently preserved in Portuguese and foreign archives, are an important documentary source for the constitution of the Portuguese and missionary linguistics historiography of Portuguese. This project intends, in the first place, to collect, latin-portuguese manuscripts from the 14th and 15th centuries foundational of the grammatical, and pedagogical thought of the Middle Ages in Portugal; also, to collect the first editions of texts of grammatical and pedagogical thought of the Portuguese language taken by epistemologically representative of 15th century to 19th century Portuguese language studies; Portuguese works, produced in colonial and missionary context, and dedicated to the analysis of non-european native languages. After the collection of those documents, this project aims to scan them and to produce and organize scientific studies that contextualize linguistic, educational, and cultural ideas exhibited there, showing, where this proves, evidence based in comparative data, scientific assessment of the framework of the ideas involved in the overall European metalinguistic production of the time; concluding by its contribution to the Portuguese metalinguistic tradition, or by its contribution to the introduction of innovative features in the study of the Portuguese language. It is also proposed to provide an updated and comprehensive bibliography of all scientific works (secondary sources) that, having remained unpublished both at the national or international levels, have had such works under the scope. Thus, this project will contribute to the formation of a corpus of linguistic metatexts that will allow the study of the evolution of the grammatical and linguistic thought of the Portuguese language, but also the evolution of the language(s) from the Middle Ages to the beginning of the 20th century. Therefore, it is also intended to publish, and/or electronically, semi-diplomatic editions of the first texts published in 15th century Portuguese language, to contribute to the development of a Medieval and Renaissance dictionary of Portuguese. We also intend to study linguistic and culturally the five Books of Records of King Manuel I from the 16th century, as well as the Charters of the region of Trás-os-Montes and Alto Douro region since the reign of Fernando Magno of Castille to that of King Manuel I, producing diplomatic editions, and statistical and lexical studies. It will also include the synchronic study of the Portuguese language of different times, especially contemporary Portuguese. In this context, we will study languages (Mirandês) and dialectal variants, such as Barrosão, spoken in Portugal and some aspects of sociolinguistic, namely the use of Portuguese language by males and females.

3.2.2. Plan and Methods

Metalinguistic studies of the Portuguese language, manuscripts and printed, currently preserved in Portuguese and foreign major European cities such as Paris, Berlin, and Madrid, but also in study centers as Oxford, Salamanca, Simancas, and the Community of Countries of Portuguese Language (CPLP)) are an important documentary source for the constitution of the Portuguese missionary linguistics historiography of Portuguese origin. We must, therefore, not only ensure the preservation of these documents, providing all international researchers, by digitization and storage in digital media of that information, access to them adaptable to the publication in digital media. With this research project is intended, therefore, in the first place, to collect, in print or digitization, latin-portuguese manuscripts from the 14th and 15th centuries foundational of the linguistic, grammatical, and of the Middle Ages in Portugal - two very important studies of latin-portuguese syntax, Ms. Digby 26, in Oxford, particularly *Reglas para enformarmos os menyos en latim* (fl. 76r-82v), 14 folios, written in the fourteenth century and used in English schools in the fifteenth century, and, at the National Library in Lisbon, the Ms. Code Alc. 79 entitled *Hic incipiunt notabilia quae fecit cunctis* 177 folios, written in 1427, at the Monastery of Alcobaca, a text devoted to the instruction in Latin, confirming the link with Gregorio and represents the beginning of the study of speculative grammar in Portugal; also the first editions of texts of grammatical nature of the Portuguese language taken by epistemologically representative of 15th century to 19th century Portuguese language studies. These studies shape the Portuguese linguistic thought since the first Portuguese publication on the Portuguese language (1536) in the nineteenth century (1899), once introduced, publicly, in the country in 1868 and in 1870, scientific methodology for the analysis and, also, Portuguese works, produced in colonial and missionary context, and dedicated to the analysis of non-european native languages, particularly American, like Tupinambá, Indian, like Tamil and Konkani, in the far-east, such as Japanese, Mandarin and Filipino, and African, such as Quimbundo, Mina-Jeje, Yorubaland, and the language Arda, which undoubtedly influenced the variants of African Portuguese, and the Creoles of Cape Verde, Guinea Bissau, and S. Tome and Principe. Then, this project aims to make the scientific studies of these documents and to produce and organize scientific studies that contextualize and describe, from the historical-epistemological perspective, linguistic, educational, and cultural ideas exhibited there, showing, where this proves, particularly if there is one or more of the same author, an exhibition of comparative data, so that is provided assessment of the framework of the ideas involved in the metalinguistic production of the time; concluding of their roots in Portuguese metalinguistic tradition, or by its contribution to innovative features in the study of the Portuguese language. It is also proposed to provide an updated and comprehensive bibliography of scientific works (secondary sources) that, having been published or remaining unpublished both at the national or international level, such works under the scope. It is also an aim to organize international seminars for the publicizing of the results that the presentation of unpublished papers that interested researchers will devote to the Historiography of Portuguese and Missionary Linguistics. This project will make possible the formation of a corpus of linguistic metatexts that will allow the study of the evolution of the linguistic thought in Portugal, but also the evolution of the language(s) from the Middle Ages to the beginning of the 20th century. It is also intended to publish, in print and/or electronically, semi-diplomatic editions of the first texts published in 15th century Portuguese language: the *Crónica de D. Duarte de Menezes*, de Gomes Eanes de Zurara, the *De Vita Christi* (1495), and *Evangelhos e Epístolas* (1495) and the development of a Medieval and Renaissance dictionary of Portuguese. We also intend to study linguistically and culturally the *Records from the charts of King Manuel I* from the 16th century, as well as the *Charters of the region of Trás-os-Montes and Alto Douro* since the reign of King Fernando Magno of Castille to that of King Manuel I, producing diplomatic editions, and statistical and cartographic studies. It will also be encouraged the synchronic study of the Portuguese language of different times, especially contemporary Portuguese. It will study minority languages (Mirandês) and dialectal variants, such as Barrosão, spoken in Portugal and some aspects of sociolinguistics, the differences in the use of Portuguese language by males and females. In short, this research project will try to accomplish the following objectives: - To scan works of linguistic-didactic nature of the 14th and 15th centuries representing the Middle Ages latin-portuguese manuscripts in the areas of linguistics; - Make the transcription, paleographic analysis and facsimile and diplomatic editing, on paper and/or digital form, of *Reglas para enformarmos os menyos en latim* (fl. 76r-82v), 14 folios, and of *Hic incipiunt notabilia quae fecit cunctis*. (fl. 1r-8v), 177 folios. - Scan works of metalinguistic nature, between 1536 and 1899, that shape epistemologically the Portuguese linguistic thought, contextualizing scientific studies and describing the Portuguese and latin-portuguese linguistic, cultural, and pedagogical ideas; - Select the works; - To prepare, for each of the Portuguese metalinguistic selected texts, between the 14th and 19th centuries, a bibliography referring to scientific studies which have been focused on them; - Organize semi-diplomatic editions, in print and digital form, of the first texts published in Portuguese language in the fifteenth century, particularly of *Crónica de D. Duarte de Menezes* by Gregorio de Zurara, the *De Vita Christi*, and *Evangelhos e Epístolas*. - Publish, in diplomatic and corrected edition, the five *Livros de Registo manuelinos* from the 16th century, as well as the *Charters of Trás-os-Montes and Alto Douro* region since the reign of King Fernando Magno of Castile to that of King Manuel I. - Elaborate synchronic studies of the Portuguese language of different times, especially contemporary Portuguese. - Transcribe and edit it on paper and/or digital form, some of the most representative works of missionary linguistics, of native languages, particularly those that most directly influenced the variants of the Portuguese language and enriched its lexicon; - and cultural landscapes in the fiction of African Portuguese speaking countries; - Compare the African oral literature of the colonial period with the fiction produced after independence; - Create an online site (Internet) in English, in order to disseminate research results.

This group has two main projects: 1. Communication as a critical factor of change in developing regions: The case of TMAD; 2. Communication: The Autobiographical Representation of political actors. It will continue the research in Communication Sciences and the PhD in Corporate Communication at University of Trás-os-Montes and Alto Douro Having already established protocols for scientific cooperation with a research center at the Complutense University of Madrid (FONTA), the group will establish in 2011 and 2012 more protocols of cooperation with scientific research centers at the Autonomous University of Barcelona, and with other universities.
