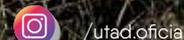

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The University of Trás-os-Montes e Alto Douro

The University of Trás-os-Montes e Alto Douro (UTAD) is a public university open to society and the world. It was the first higher education institution created in the interior region of northern Portugal. Established as an agrarian Polytechnic Institute in 1973, it became a University in 1986.

Today, through its Schools of Agriculture and Veterinary Sciences, Science and Technology, Life Sciences and Environment, Humanities and Social Sciences, and Health, UTAD offers about 100 courses of bachelor, master and doctorate degrees.

It promotes research and community projects that contribute to the scientific and technological innovation, improving teaching quality and the socio-economic and cultural development.

It encourages international exchanges, and close collaboration with institutions around the world, as part of various European and international research, training and mobility programs.

UTAD is an ecosystem of learning and skills development, made of multidisciplinary knowledge, and an institution that values and encourages close relationships between about 500 teachers and over 7,000 students from Portugal and other countries.

As part of its Strategic Plan, and for the period 2017/2021, UTAD intends to build an ECO-UNIVERSITY, an institution committed to the involvement of the academia and the community in shaping responses to the great contemporary societal challenges.



A green campus full of opportunities

The campus is a botanical garden where infrastructures fully meet all quality requirements of teaching, research and leisure: library and museum, classrooms and study spaces, laboratories, experimental areas, auditoriums and sports facilities, widespread broadband wireless network.

The Office of International Relations and Mobility (GRIM) is the operational support structure for the internationalization and academic mobility policy of UTAD, promoting, coordinating, accompanying and supporting projects and actions in this field. The Office:

- Disseminates information on cooperation and academic mobility programs and initiatives and their funding lines;
- Promotes the recruitment of international students;
- Participates in international educational exhibitions and fairs;
- Promotes UTAD's participation in cooperation programs in the areas of teaching and academic mobility;
- Manages and implements mobility projects and actions, guaranteeing the support to the national and international academic community;
- Supports the process of negotiating cooperation agreements with foreign institutions;
- Promotes recognition and supports university participation in networks, consortia and other international cooperation projects and initiatives.
