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#### INTRODUCTION

The Activity Plan for 2021 identifies 52 activities aligned with the Strategic Axes and Objectives of the Strategic Plan 2017-2021.

These activities were aligned with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) recommended by the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, which defines the priorities and aspirations of global sustainable development for 2030 and seeks to mobilize global efforts around a set of common goals and targets. There are 17 SDGs that represent an urgent call to action from all countries - developed and developing - for a global partnership.

2021 was a year of many setbacks, and above all due to the restrictions caused by Pandemic COVID19, which forced the cancellation of many activities, confinement of people, limited access, among others, which severely limited the realization of certain types of actions. However, it was possible to develop other activities (not dependent on the Strategic Planning) and R&D projects with the proper alignment to the SDGs.

#### **ACTIVITIES FORESEEN IN THE ACTIVITY PLAN**

Of the 52 activities planned for 2021, 34 (65%) directly contribute to the promotion of the Sustainable Development Goals.



#### THE IMPACT RANKING 2021

UTAD has participated in The Times Higher Education Impact Ranking that aims to measure, globally, higher education institutions in relation to the achievement of SDG 2030.
